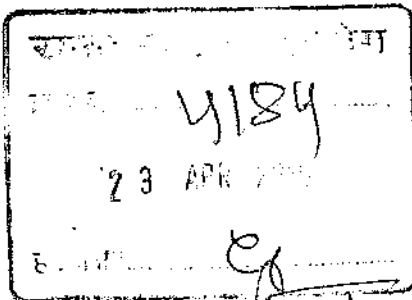

**SUPPLEMENTARY AGENDA FOR MEETING WITH PRINCIPAL SECRETARIES
(PERSONNEL /GAD) OF THE STATE GOVERNMENTS ON 9.9.2014**

(1) Implementation of the Suo motu guidelines in the state governments:

Guidelines to Central Ministries/departments for proactive disclosure under Section 4 of the RTI Act were issued by DOPT on 15.4.2013. Guidelines for State governments along with templates for disclosure at various levels under Public Distribution System, Panchayats, MGNREGA, primary and secondary schools were also prepared for better implementation of the suo motu disclosure at state level. A D.O. letter was written by Secretary (P) on 21st November, 2013 to the Chief Secretaries requesting them to consider issuing similar guidelines and templates for disclosures at the state level. However, reportedly these guidelines and templates are yet to be implemented by the states.

(2) RTI online web portal for receiving RTI applications and appeals:

The RTI online web portal has been developed by National Informatics Centre with a payment gateway by State Bank of India for receiving RTI applications and appeals online. The facility is presently available to all the Central Ministries/departments of GOI since August 2013. Secretary(P) had written a D. O. letter to all Chief Secretaries requesting them to explore the feasibility of implementing online RTI in their states on similar lines for which NIC would provide technical support such as software and source code to the state governments desiring to replicate the facility. The state government may request SBI to provide the payment gateway for receiving the RTI fees. Till date, only Governments of Maharashtra, Puducherry and Karnataka have initiated action in this regard.

(3) ATIs which are not availing of the funds under the plan scheme on RTI or are not furnishing the utilisation certificates for the funds availed of:

Several ATIs(list attached) are either not submitting proposals for availing of the funds under the plan scheme on RTI or if they have availed of the funds, then they have not furnished the utilisation certificates even long after the due date. It appears that many of the ATIs have not been provided with the necessary facilities in terms of infrastructure, staff, etc for conducting training programmes and other activities as per the guidelines of DOPT. The State governments need to review the working of such ATIs to provide the necessary infrastructure and other facilities so that capacity building and awareness generation activities can be conducted by the ATIs for better implementation of the RTI Act.

(4) Compendium of best practices on RTI:

In the year 2013, a compendium of best practices in public authorities on RTI (1st volume) was released and uploaded on the website of DOPT. This year, it is proposed to publish second volume of the compendium of best practices being followed by public authorities. An advertisement to invite write ups has already been published on the website of DOPT. The state governments may be requested to contribute write ups on the best practises on RTI adopted by public authorities under them. The best practices could be such that facilitate dissemination of information in any form, to encourage the spirit of RTI.
